Class Schedule

We will place students in the appropriate class based on age and experience.

Weekly classes are held Mondays and Thursdays.

Kids Class age 5-7: 5:30pm-6:15pm

Kids Class age 8+: 6:15pm-7:00pm

Teen Class: 6:30pm-7:30pm

Women's Class: 6:30pm-7:30pm+

Adult Class: 6:30pm-7:30pm+

Blue Belt + Advanced Tech Class: Wednesdays at 6:30pm

Additional special seminars and classes will be held throughout the year for our students.

Monthly Tuition Fees

Kid/Teen Classes - \$50

Adult Classes - \$75

Teen/Adult Punch Card - \$100/10 classes

Family Discounts - 2-3 people: first student/adult is full price, each additional student receives a \$10 discount. 4 or more people: first student/adult is full price, each additional student receives a \$20 discount.

All monthly tuition payments are due **by the 10th of each month**. Any payment accepted after the 10th of the month will be subject to a \$10.00 late fee. Please place all payments in provided envelopes located in the waiting room and into the drop box. Fill out the information on the envelope so we properly credit your account each month. We charge a \$20 returned check fee.

Class Punch Card for Adults

Purchased cards may be kept in the file box in the classroom or with the owner. Cards will be marked by the instructor at the start of each class. Cards are not transferable and cannot be shared. ACC is not responsible for lost cards.

Waivers

All students must have a completed waiver to be able to train.

Key Fob

For the convenience of our students, the ACC building uses a keyless entry system. Key fobs are intended to allow entrance only to the ACC student and accompanying parent/guardian. Key fobs require a one time deposit of \$10, fully refundable when the fob is returned.

Sign In

Please be sure to sign in prior to each class. A clipboard with the class list and class dates will be used to track attendance. Please find your name and put an **X** in the appropriate box for that date. If your name is not on the list, please add it to the bottom. We are not responsible for missed sign-ins.

Cancellations

We will notify ACC members of class cancellations or changes on our Facebook Page and via the Group Me app.

Classroom

In an effort to keep our mats sanitary, we ask that there never be shoes on the mats. Shoes should be placed in the designated shoe area. No gum, candy, food or drinks on the mats. We ask that only students enter the classroom each week. Parents can watch the class on the monitor in the waiting room.

Illness and Hygiene

Jiu-Jitsu is an “up close & personal” sport. Please do not attend class if you are ill or have a contagious skin condition. You will not be allowed to participate. Keep fingers and toe nails short and clean to prevent injury to yourself and others. Wear a clean, dry gi to each class. Please remove jewelry prior to class.

Skills Tracking

Student’s Brazilian Jiu-Jitsu skills will be tracked by our instructors and recorded on student skill cards. Skill level is taken into consideration in belt advancement.

Belts and Stripes

The ACC adheres to the International Brazilian Jiu-Jitsu Federation (IBJJF) General System of Graduation when awarding advancements to our students. We will celebrate our students’ successes on the second and fourth Monday of each month by awarding newly earned belts and belt stripes.

Kids class students earn belt stripes every 12 lessons, and at the instructor’s discretion, for the first 2

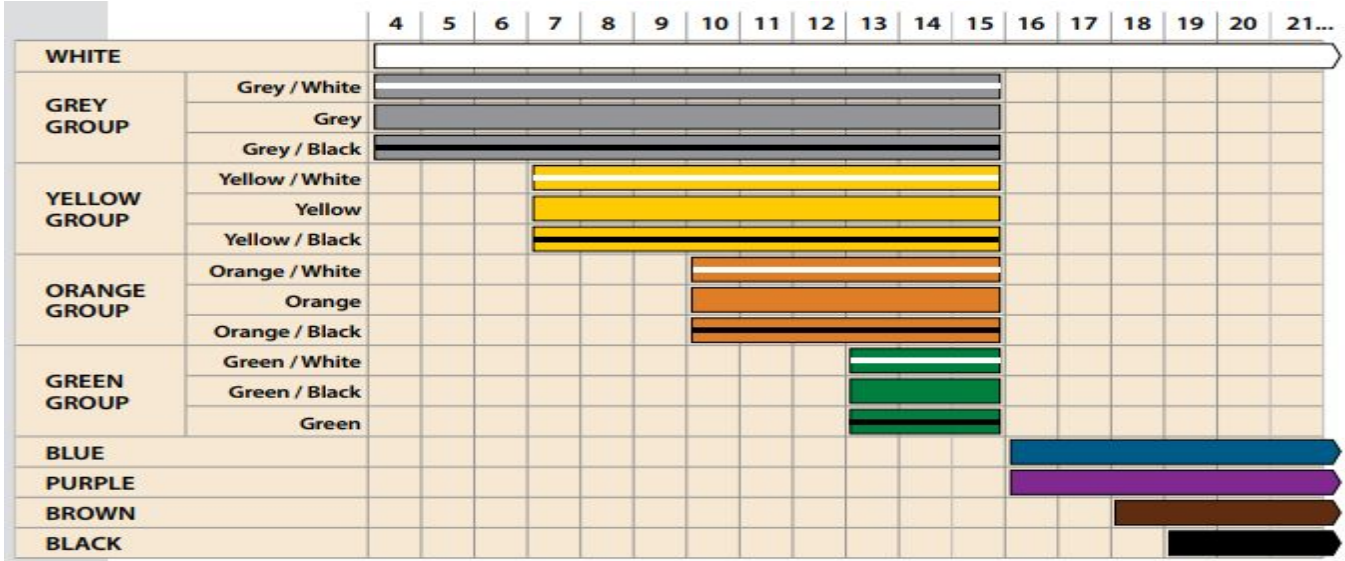
belts (white and gray/white). These students are eligible to advance to the next belt after 72 lessons (5 stripes + 12 lessons).

Youth students with gray belts and higher earn belt stripes every 36 lessons, and at the instructor's discretion. These students are eligible to advance to the next belt every 144 lessons (3 stripes + 36 lessons).

Adults earn stripes every 48 lessons, and at the instructor's discretion. These students are eligible to advance to the next belt every 240 lessons (4 stripes + 48 lessons).

Please note: Student accounts must be up-to-date to be eligible for any advancement.

Gi and Belt Orders

ACC offers a discount through Gameness.com. Please see our Gi order form in the waiting room to place an order. Our staff will alert you when a new belt is close to being earned. New belts will be ordered when we receive payment. Please place any gi and belt payment in an envelope labeled with the student name and belt size and place it in the drop box located in the waiting room. Belt sizes can be found at www.Gameness.com

We encourage our students ordering a gi to add the ACC patch to shoulder, chest, back, or leg of the gi. We will be moving towards requiring our students to display our patch in the future.

Our students are registered with the IBJJF and as such a belting fee is charged for each advancement. The belting fee is \$30 for youth belts gray/white and higher, \$200 and up for adult (age 16+) blue belts and higher. Fees are due when belt is purchased.
